KENYA MISSION REPORT

It was on the 2nd of December 2023 that we started our trip to Kenya for the annual convention in Tongareni a sub-county of Busia County in Western Kenya.

Bro Mike Murombezi a fellow minister in our small town of Chitungwiza and I boarded the bus and started off from Harare (the capital city of our country Zimbabwe) at 13:00hrs.
